Luke 4: 24: "And he said 'truly I tell you, no prophet is accepted in the prophet's hometown.'

Psalms: 93: "The Lord is King, he is robed in majesty; the Lord is robed, he is girded with strength. He has established the world; it shall never be moved; your throne is established from of old; you are from everlasting."
