

What You Can Expect When Participating in a Crossroads UMC Ministry Event

As we work through the evolving coronavirus pandemic, we want to keep you apprised of what you should expect if you participate in an in-person ministry event. The information below is subject to change; changes will be posted and highlighted for clarity, as they are incorporated.

Expectations for Small Group Events

- Each small group event will be led by a designated Group Leader who will 1) schedule the event with Crossroads UMC, 2) gather some information from you, including responses to the required Health Questionnaire, 3) ensure all participants follow the prescribed health and safety protocols during the event, and 4) fulfill any post-event reporting requirements.
- You must make a reservation with the Group Leader to attend each event to ensure adherence with occupancy limitations based upon social distancing guidelines.
- Group Leaders will collect your verbal responses to the Health Questionnaire upon arrival, as well as your contact information.
- To ensure the health and safety of all, you will not be permitted to participate in the event, nor allowed access to the facility, unless you are able to affirmatively respond to all items on the Health Questionnaire.
- As Spaces utilized for the event will have been appropriately cleaned, only assigned areas may be occupied.
- Signs will be posted throughout the facility providing reminders for social distancing, wearing face coverings, and handwashing. Additionally, facility entrance and exit points may be limited to better control facility access. In such instances, signs will clearly direct you to the appropriate entrance point.
- The practice of social distancing is required. Wearing a face mask is mandatory and must remain in use at all times. There are no exceptions.
- Bathrooms will be open but restricted to one person use at a time.
