CHILDREN'S MINISTRY VOLUNTEER ROLES

TABLE TEAM GUIDE

Gets to... welcome and lead an assigned Table Team of elementary-aged children and support their experience and safety during the hour's activities (including worship, service projects, craft, game, snack, conversation, etc. varying weekly). This adult will be responsible for 6-10 children with the support of one or more adult or teen assistants.

PRESCHOOL LEAD TEACHER

Gets to... welcome and teach our preschoolers by leading activities including worship, service projects, craft, game, snack, conversation, etc. varying weekly. This adult will be supported by one or more adult or teen assistants.

TABLE TEAM OR PRESCHOOL ASSISTANT

Gets to... assist a Table Team Guide or Preschool Teacher and support children during the hour's activities (including worship, service projects, craft, game, snack, conversation, etc. varying weekly).

WELCOMER

Gets to... provide a warm welcome to children and families and help with sign-in and registration. After families have arrived, the Welcomer can go to the sanctuary to enjoy the week's message.

WORSHIP AND MOVEMENT LEADER

Gets to... lead elementary-aged children in fun songs, motions, and dance, channeling the group's joyful energy towards worshipping God.

STORYTELLER

Gets to... share an engaging and age-appropriate Bible story with the group, always tying back to our core message, "love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength, and love your neighbor as you love yourself."

SET UP AND PREP

Gets to... help prepare supplies and materials earlier in the week or arrive before the Sunday Service and help set tables, stations, and decorations to welcome families.
