Overview

The **Sound Technician** position is vital to the ongoing success of Crossroads' ability to live into our vision of extending God's Unconditional Love, Unwavering Hope, and Unlimited Welcome to the Crossroads' community.

The **Sound Technician** is responsible for producing the best possible atmosphere for worship and other Crossroads events through sound reinforcement. This includes, but is not limited to, creating the best music mix possible to support the audio needs of those who are involved in the worship services and other events including mixing and monitoring sound for the Live Stream of worship.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Sundays 7:00 am to 11:30 am
- Wednesdays 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm
- Additional rehearsals and set up for other events as needed
- Weekly meeting with Worship Integrator
- Participate in Worship Design Team meetings
- *Pre service/events*
 - Set up sound equipment for all worship services, events and rehearsals.
 - Perform proper line checks and sound check; includes gain setting, monitor mixes, volume settings and the equalizer/mixing process.
 - Check and monitor audio mix for the Live Stream of Sunday Worship and other events.
 - Check with worship leader and pastor at each event/service for any schedule changes.
- *During Service*
 - Responsible for adjusting sound levels during service as needed.
 - Follow worship leader's direction and musicians' directions during services. For example, adjusting monitor levels.
 - Actively follow stage and schedule cues during each service/event.
 - Work to provide a distraction-free service as it relates to audio production.
- *Post-service*
 - Talk with the band to find out if issues existed for them during service.
 - Note any broken/faulty equipment and take it out of service if possible.
 - Clear stage of equipment as needed

Qualifications

- A heart for creating a worshipful atmosphere through sound reinforcement.
- Able to work in team settings and take directions.
- Experience mixing audio successfully in the live environment and are willing to attend training and work alongside a mentor.
- Good communication and inter-personal skills. Ability to think quickly and react/trouble-shoot properly in high stress situations.
- Willing to attend training sessions and read/watch other training material for improving existing skills
- Eye and ear for excellence
- Ability to use technology and work with volunteers to produce creative, distraction free environments for worship and other events.
- Detail oriented. Ability to take the initiative on creative processes, assignments and problem solving.

Other Requirements

- Must be able to pass background check.
- Must be able to have physical dexterity to use computer, phone, and other office equipment
- Requires walking, standing, climbing stairs, and bending to perform duties.
